News and Views

The special haftarah of Shabbat Shuva is made up of three parts, from the Biblical prophets Hoshea, Micha and Yoel. The first part calls on Israel to return to God; even after sinning, their return will be lovingly accepted.

The opening words "Shuva Yisrael ad Hashem...return to God O Israel", give this Shabbat its name, Shabbat Shuva, the Shabbat of Return.

Hoshea's plea is accompanied by inspiring prophecies of redemption and the restoration of Israel's former glory.

The second part states that God is unique in His readiness to pardon, and the last part emphasises that our teshuvah (return/repentance) has to be sincere and heartfelt, not just lip service. This passage from Yoel mentions the Shofar and alludes to the fast of Yom Kippur.
